When is it happening?

Wednesday, October 5th through Sunday, October 9th (fall break for most schools)
We will leave for Kentucky on Wednesday morning and return home Sunday evening.

Where are we going?

Rural Appalachia - specifically, Big Creek Missions in Bear Branch, Kentucky

Who can participate?

Families! Young or old, married or single, and everyone in between. Every child who attends must be accompanied by a caregiver who is a family member. Friends who are not FBC members are welcome.

What will we do?

Partner with Big Creek Missions to do projects, strengthen relationships and share the Gospel in the community. Possible projects include construction, food pantry, local schools, Saturday day camp and more. Specific projects will be finalized in September and customized for the ages and skills of the team we bring. There will be a place for everyone to serve!

Where will we stay?

Big Creek Missions is housed in a converted elementary school with bunk rooms, worship space, a cafeteria, showers and an outdoor space. Several families will share each bunk room.

What will we eat?

All meals will be provided by Big Creek Missions. Meals are family-friendly, and staff can accommodate most dietary restrictions. Their sweet tea is legendary!

How much will it cost?

\$100 per adult, \$75 per child (2-17), free for under 2, FAMILY MAX of \$400
Families will be responsible for transportation to and from Bear Branch, KY and to mission sites. Families will pack or purchase meals on the road on Wednesday and Sunday.
